Reading

Please try to read for 5 minutes every night through the week. It is the only way for the children to learn to read fluently. School is busy and although we do lots of reading regular practise reading at home will make a huge difference to what your child can do.

Please write in yellow reading records every time you listen to your child read and send these into school every day.

Home Learning EYFS



- Reading every night
- Phonics home learning books will be sent home every Tuesday with the new phonemes for that week. Please practise reading the words on the sheet and practise forming the new letters.
- Reading books are changed at least every Tuesday. Please send them
 every day as we aim to listen to the children read whenever possible
 in school and times may vary.

Home Learning Year One



- Reading every night
- Phonics home learning books will be sent home every Tuesday with the new phoneme for that week. Please work with your child to complete the activity sheet.

Tricky words

We are working very hard practising reading and spelling tricky words. Each child has lists to practise alongside their reading books.

• Spellings

Year One spelling tests are every Monday. Spelling lists are sent home with phonics home learning every Tuesday ready for the following week. Please practise on paper and also on games on Spelling Shed. The children love this! Words are updated every Monday. Login details are on the front of their yellow reading records books.

• Maths

Optional activities on the website added at the end of each half term.

Behaviour and Expectations

- At the start of the year we work hard to learn our school routines and expectations.
- We give lots of praise and encouragement for kindness, lovely manners, good listening, kind hands and showing that they are ready to learn and working hard.
- We have a traffic light system for behaviour superstar, green, amber, red.
- All children begin the day on green and can work their way to the superstar. If reminders are needed about expectations then a warning is given and then if another reminder is needed then children are moved to amber. The consequence for this is missing 2 minutes of play (EYFS) or 5 minutes (Year One). Adults talk through what happened and what we can do differently next time. Children can then move back to green.
- Lots of Rewards: respect pebbles, house points, stickers, BOB, star of the week, certificates.
