PSHE

How can our choices make a difference to others and the environment?

How we care for others, the environment, people and animals. Discuss our shared responsibilities, how to make choices and decisions.

PE

Swimming Athletics Improve their strength and control in their movements through athletics

Science

Electricity

- identify common appliances that run on electricity
- construct a simple series electrical circuit, identifying and naming its basic parts, including cells, wires, bulbs, switches and buzzers
- identify whether or not a lamp will light in a simple series circuit, based on whether or not the lamp is part of a complete loop with a battery
- recognise that a switch opens and closes a circuit and associate this with whether or not a lamp lights in a simple series circuit
- recognise some common conductors and insulators, and associate metals with being good conductors.

Maths

This term we will be looking at:

Fractions, decimals, money, time, shape, statistics, position and direction as well as continuing to focus on basic number bonds particularly times tables.

Computing

This term we will be focussing on:

Unit 3.6 Branching Databases Select, use and combine a variety of software (including internet services) on a range of digital devices to design and create a range of programs, systems and content that accomplish given goals, including collecting, analysing, evaluating and presenting data and information.

Unit 3.7 Simulations Use sequence, selection, and repetition in programs; work with variables and various forms of input and output.

Unit 3.8 Graphing Use search technologies effectively, appreciate how results are selected and ranked, and be discerning in evaluating digital content.

Geography

What are the challenges of nature?

Children learn about how people have adapted to live in areas where nature poses a challenge.

Children recap the challenges facing the residents of Cockerham and surrounding areas due to flooding. They learn about earthquakes and consider the challenges for the North American city of San Francisco due to Earthquakes. They explore the differing human geography and some of San Francisco's super structures linked to DT (Autumn term). They learn how people deal with earthquakes and the immediate and secondary effects of earthquakes.

English

This half term we will focus on:

Classic Poetry, Stories on a theme and Information Booklets We will also be working on recapping phonics, spelling, punctuation and grammar previously learned and extending into using speech marks and paragraphing.

We will be using the 'Think it, Say it, Write it, Read it, Check it' approach to writing.
